The Southern Arizona Appaloosa Promoters Open Breed Horse Shows are intended to be safe and fun learning experiences with good sportsmanship for horse and rider. These shows are open to all horses and riders. Show volunteers will endeavor to be prompt, helpful and courteous

#### Rules & Information

These shows adhere to the SAAP Rule Book and the ApHC Handbook. These books can be viewed at the office.

1. Management has the right to excuse any rider or horse for safety or unsportsmanlike behavior. Rules for disputes and refunding of scratched classes will be posted at the office.
2. **ENTRIES:** Enter at the show or Pre Enter by mail. The office will open at 8am. We accept cash or check.

**FEES:** \$10.00 insurance fee per horse  
\$8.00 per class

#### 3. DIVISION CLASSES

Your age on 1/1/2018 applies to the entire year. These classes apply to High Point Awards. Walk-Trot Riders CANNOT compete or school in any classes except Walk-Trot and Try The Canter/Lope classes.

- **Adult 19-49:** Any adult rider age 19 -49.
- **Adult 50 & Better:** Any adult rider age 50 and older.
- **Adult Walk Trot:** Any beginner rider, age 19 & older, who is not ready to canter.
- **Open:** Classes for all ages except walk trot.
- **Young Youth:** Riders age 13 & under
- **Older Youth:** Riders age 14-18.
- **Youth Walk Trot:** Any beginner rider, age 18 & under, who is not ready to canter.

#### 4. NON-DIVISION CLASSES

These classes do not apply to High Point Awards.

- **Try The Canter / Try the Lope Classes:** These classes are for Walk-Trot Riders only. They are intended to give the beginner rider a chance to try the canter or lope without having to compete in the canter divisions.

#### Additional Information

- Proper show attire is **required**. Long Pants, Proper Riding Boots & Long Sleeved Shirt. Western riders are allowed (and encouraged) to wear helmets.
- **PATTERNS** will be available day of show
- **BREAKS may be shortened or canceled but changes will be announced.** The main arena will be open for warm up during all breaks.
- A class may be canceled or combined with another class if there are less than three entries. A large class may be split with both classes receiving points.

## Award Information

Riders who are excused due to unsportsmanlike behavior will lose eligibility for any awards.

### Class awards

- Each class is placed 1st-5<sup>th</sup>. Ribbons will be at show office
- Points are earned as follows:
- 1<sup>st</sup> place 5 points
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place 4 points
- 3<sup>rd</sup> place is 3 points
- 4<sup>th</sup> place is 2 points
- 5<sup>th</sup> place is 1 point

**High Point and Reserve Awards** will be given for all seven divisions at each show. **To be eligible for High Point awards riders must declare the division that they wish to compete for awards in when signing up.**

1. Any division with less than five declared riders will only be awarded High Point.
2. Points earned in other division classes that the rider qualifies for are applied to the division that the rider declares for High Point awards. Try The Canter/Lope classes do not count towards any High Point Awards.

Example: A 13 year old rider who chooses Open for High Point can earn points from both Open classes and Young Youth Classes towards their Open High Point.
